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Dear Families,

We seem to have reached the half term break in the blink of an eye. It's been a fun filled half term with lots of exciting lessons and activities taking place in each of the classrooms, maintaining the vibrance, energy and engagement with learning, that we are proud of at Cusgarne.

This is always a good time to reflect on some of the achievements of our classes and pupils. Last week, 27 of our wonderful year 4, 5 & 6 children ran in the Richard Lander School Cluster Cross Country event, competing alongside over 300 children from surrounding primary schools. Some of the Kingfisher children competed in a swimming gala held at Truro School's swimming pool, an event coordinated by Richard Lander School. They overcame their nerves and delivered 100% effort. We couldn't have been prouder, and I know the children thoroughly enjoyed it.

Robin Class have been making the most of our outdoor Forest School this term and haven't let the wintery weather stop them from getting out and embracing their outdoor learning. They've demonstrated resilience, teamwork, joined up thinking and creativity. Some of the activities they have enjoyed are printing with leaves, shelter building and celebrating the Chinese New Year with their own creations, including our newest creation to the Forest School area – a giant rabbit made of pallets! Thank you to Mrs Denton for all her hard work.

Starling Class have enjoyed some fun themed 'hook' days linked to their learning topics, including Dragons Den and Hotel guest days. It was wonderful to see their excitement and enthusiasm, along with their outfits, and to hear them talk about all the fun things they'd done, which incorporated cross curricular topics.

Year 6 children have been attending some revision classes to help them prepare for SATS, and these sessions will continue after the half term break. Thank you to Miss Medcalf for organising these sessions for our children.

Some dates for your diaries - the Cornwall Music Festival is coming up soon on 13th March in the afternoon, and our classes have been busy learning the spoken-word pieces they'll be performing. This is always a brilliant occasion, enjoyed by all, and parents are welcome to attend this. The event is held at The Wesley Hall in Truro, further details will follow nearer the time. We will have an end of term music assembly at which all children will be performing, on Friday 31st March. Other things to look forward to (details to be issued in time) – a Cornwall Wildlife Trust visit for Starling and Robin Classes, and Year 6's have a careers event coming up. A little further away, we have managed to secure tickets to take all children to Paignton Zoo at the end of June to mark the centenary of the zoo. Friends will be fundraising beforehand to help with the cost of transport for this trip, for which I am so grateful.
